Welcome to the year 2009! It's February and that means it has been one year since our family first visited and had our lives dramatically changed by the Kingdom of Swaziland. It was one year ago we met a young girl of six years who was the head of household for herself and her two younger siblings. It has been a year since we met a little girl who had no family, and no one to care for her as she prepared to die from the AIDS that had infected her body. It has been a year since we met the GoGos who give so much to care for the shattered world their country has become. It has been a year since we first had our eyes opened to how much the Kingdom of Swaziland needs the physical presence of the Body of Christ.

2008 was a year of change for our family. We whittled away many of our possessions, we changed habits, and took many other steps to prepare for our transition to life in the Swazi kingdom. As 2008 concluded, we have felt on so many levels like this is our time, and we are ready to move from life here in Chicago, to our roles in the Nsoko orphan village.



However, at this point we have not been given the green light to go. At this time we still have a house, with a mortgage that has not yet sold. That means we still have ties and responsibilities here.

Please pray for our family's transitions. Pray that God would bind any delay that has impeded our progress. Pray that we would have open doors, and our situation with the house would be quickly resolved, and our buyer would arrive to propel us into this next transition, into God's work in Nsoko, Swaziland.
